***PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGES**

Third printing July 2005

ARTICLE - 6 – MEMBERSHIP & DUES

Section I – Add

And is subject to probation for one year and must put in twenty (20) – hours of work in this probation year.

ATTACHMENT - A – Add

Is for non-probationary members.

SECTION – 5 –Add

Associate membership shall not be counted in determining total club membership and must be sponsored by at least two (2) members in good standing.

Associate shall not receive separate club mailings or the Michigan out-of-doors magazine.

SECTION –13-CHANGE

Before March 1 to February 1

SECTION – 14- CHANGE

Default in his or her dues as of March 31 to February 28th

ARTICLE –7- STANDING COMMITTEES

Delete – Farmers Relations

Add – IDPA, Range Safety Committee, Public Relations
