**TCLS is having a
Defensive Pistol
Scenario Shoot**

Perhaps you've wondered what it would be like to shoot a Self Defense Scenario with your handgun but didn't know where you might try it. Or, perhaps you've heard about the IDPA group at Tri-County and wondered what that was all about but were shy about coming to a match.

Well, here's your opportunity!

Bring your handgun along with your rifle or shotgun to the Turkey Shoots this year. You will be able to try your hand at a Defensive Pistol Scenario on our new Action Pistol Shooting Range.

This fall, on the same days as the Turkey Shoots (October 9th and 23rd; and November 6th and 13th) the Tri-County Sportsman's League IDPA Safety Officers will be running a practice Defensive Pistol Shoot on the new **Action Pistol Shooting Range**. For \$5 for TCSL members and \$8 for non-members you can sign up and shoot both scenarios as many times as you can fit in the day (in rotation with other shooters). For October 9th, all shooting will start with the gun on a table. All safe handguns are welcome regardless of caliber (no 50's please) and all shooting will be supervised by experienced IDPA Safety Officers.

So, bring your handgun and join us for the fun.
