PROPOSED BYLAW CHANGES

(Change Life to Senior Member)

SECTION 9. Any full member who shall have been a full member of this organization for not less than fifteen (15) consecutive years and shall have attained the age of 65 shall become a **Senior Member** and shall be presented a special membership card bearing this designation. And these members shall be assessed a fee of one **Half (1/2)** of the General Membership dues.

SECTION 4. A full member's spouse Shall be admitted for full membership Upon payment of the annual years dues. In the event of the death of a member, The membership will be offered to the Surviving spouse. This option can be Exercised one (1) time only.
