**1st LT. Sue Ann Lamia U.S. Air Force
Granddaughter of James C. Grant, TCSL,
Life Member**

Sue Ann as a high school senior in 1999 was captain of the girls swim team and graduated Summa Cum Laude with a 4.2 GPA.

She graduated from Notre Dame University in 2003. During the 3-yrs at ND she was also an Air Force ROTC cadet, and was the "wing Commander" her senior year. Upon graduation she was Commissioned as a 2nd LT. In the U.S. Air Force.

She was stationed at Wright Patterson AFB and received a pilot's license. (Piston engines) She was sent to the jet pilot's training school at Columbus, Mass., where she received her Air Force Pilots "Wings" in 2005, for flying any multiple jet engine aircraft. She was the only girl to graduate in a class of 30. She was assigned to the Charleston S.C. AF base and to fly the McDonnell Douglas C-17 Globe master heavy transport plane which has (4) 40,100 -lb. Thrust jet engines, a wing span of 165-ft & weight 580,000-lbs. (290-T)

She was sent on several 2 & 3 wk trips to the middle east. One of these assignments her C-17 plane and crew was selected to fly into Baghdad Iraq, pick up the newly elected Prime Minister and the Iraqi Ambassador to the U.S., and fly to Turkey where the Iraqi's were put on another plane for their trip to the U.S. for a meeting with President Bush. In late 2006 she spent 3-months at the air base in Qatar, off the coast of Saudi Arabia and flew into Afghanistan, Germany, Italy, Iraq and Turkey.

Sue Ann was promoted to 1st Lt. In 2006, and during the 2nd Quarter of 2006 won the award as the best, junior "Company Grade Officer" (all 1st & 2nd Lt's) for the entire "Wing" at the Charleston S. C. A.F. base, where she is presently stationed, until another assignment comes up. On her birthday in may 2007 she turned "26" -Go Fly Girl-God Bless The USA, the Servicemen.... and Women.
